

Thame Youth Projects Summer Holiday Programme Activity Information

This document contains full details for each of our activities for Summer 2025. There is no charge for attending our activities but we do incur costs. Funding is increasingly difficult to receive so if you are in a position to donate it would be greatly appreciated and help us to keep our provision going. Information on how to donate will be sent to everyone at the end of the school holidays, along with an opportunity to provide anonymous feedback.

PLEASE NOTE: We do not serve any refreshments with nuts or peanuts, however we cannot guarantee a nut free environment. We will do everything we can to accommodate dietary requirements but sometimes it isn't possible. We can't guarantee the absence or prevention of cross-contaminations of particular allergens. If a young person requires emergency medication such as epi-pen or inhaler then they must bring it to each activity otherwise they will not be allowed to sign in and join the session.

Spaces are limited and it's first come first served by submitting a consent form. We will operate a waiting list for this session if necessary.

All activities are pre-bookable only and all forms must be submitted by the deadlines given.

School year is defined as the year your child is currently in, not the school year they are about to enter.

Activity Name & Location: TYPG Holiday Book Club at Thame Library (School Years 7-13)

Date and Time: 2-4pm Tuesday 29th July 2025

Deadline for booking: 5pm Monday 28th July 2025

Other Information: A relaxed session where young people can discuss their favourite books, what they're currently reading, or just sit quietly and read. Also a good time to relax and/or chat to their peers or adults.

Cooking

Activity Name and Location: TYPG Cooking Session at Girl Guides HQ (School Years 7-11) **Date and Time:** Thursday 7th August 2025

Deadline for booking: 9am-1pm or 1:30pm Wednesday 6th August 2025

Other Information: Young people will be using kitchen equipment so they must listen and follow instructions in order to maintain safety. There will be a zero tolerance policy on any behaviour contrary, and this will result in the parent/guardian being called to collect their child. Young people should have their hair tied up and not wear nail varnish. If they experience sickness or diarrhoea within 48 hours prior to the session then they should not attend.

The menu is being decided and only a vegetarian alternative will be available. We will confirm this closer to the session. Early leave time is optional if young people wish to take their food home rather than stay and eat – please let us know.

We will not be using the park or playground so if your child signs out to use these after the session they do so at their own risk.



Golf

Activity Name and Location: TYPG Waterstock Golf (School Years 7-13) Date and Time: 1:30-3:45pm Tuesday 12th August 2025,

Other Information: A session at Waterstock driving range, co-led by our Young Leaders. Transport is provided. Pick up and drop off from LWS Upper (roadside car park). Coach will leave promptly so please arrive on time to sign in. Snack and drink provided. Waterstock will provide a selection of clubs (please let us know if you require a left handed one). Young people are welcome to bring their own clubs but Thame Youth Projects are not responsible for looking after them.

Board Games

Activity Name and Location: TYPG Board Games Session at Girl Guides HQ (School Years 6-13) Date and Time: 2-4pm Thursday 14th August 2025

Deadline for booking: 9am Thursday 14th August 2025

Other Information: A relaxed afternoon with snacks and drink provided. Young people can bring their own age appropriate games however they remain responsible for them.

We will not be using the park or playground so if your child signs out to use these during or after the session they do so at their own risk.



Film Photography

Activity Name and Location: TYPG Film Photography Walk, starting and ending at Southern Rec Ground (School Years 9-13)

Date and Time: 2-4pm [Est] Tuesday 19th August 2025

Deadline for booking: 2pm, Monday 18th August 2025

Other Information: A walk around Thame with professional photographer and lecturer <u>Tom Warland</u>, generously supported by <u>Analogue Wonderland</u>. This is an exciting opportunity to be a part of the resurgence of the film photography industry whilst exploring landscape and street photography. Cameras and film provided. There will be a digital camera for young people to use to practice their shots, and they are welcome to use their own cameras/phones but they do so at their own responsibility. Young people must follow instructions when operating the cameras provided so as not to damage them, and must not walk off from the group unless officially signing out. They should make sure they bring a bottle of water, and wear appropriate clothing and footwear. If the weather makes it impractical to carry out the session you will be contacted as soon as possible. We aim to finish around 4pm but it could be earlier, as there will be flexibility in the route we take. If your child does not have permission to sign out independently we will wait with them.

This session includes street photography which means photography in a public space. This means the group may be taking photographs that potentially include each other, and although photographing each other is not the focus it will form an integral part of the activity. The film rolls will be developed and scanned by Analogue Wonderland and sent back to TYP via email.

Ideally we would like to use images taken during this activity to promote our thanks to Tom and Analogue Wonderland on social media for generously giving their time and resources to make this provision happen, but we understand that some people will have reasons for not wanting their image online. The consent form will allow you to chose what suits you best. Please note, that no names will be used in publication.



Movie Night

Activity Name and Location: TYPG Movie Night [Films rated U, PG, 12, as decided by the BBFC] at Girl Guides HQ (School Years 6-13) Date and Time: 6:30-8:30pm Thursday 28th August 2025

Deadline for booking: 5pm Wednesday 27th August 2025

Other Information: Snack and drink provided. Young people will be given a choice of films to vote from on the night. Cinema rules will be observed: no use of phones or talking throughout the film. Young people are welcome to bring cushions/blankets to make the night more comfortable but they remain responsible for their own property.

We will not be using the park or playground so if your child signs out after the session to use these they do so at their own risk.
